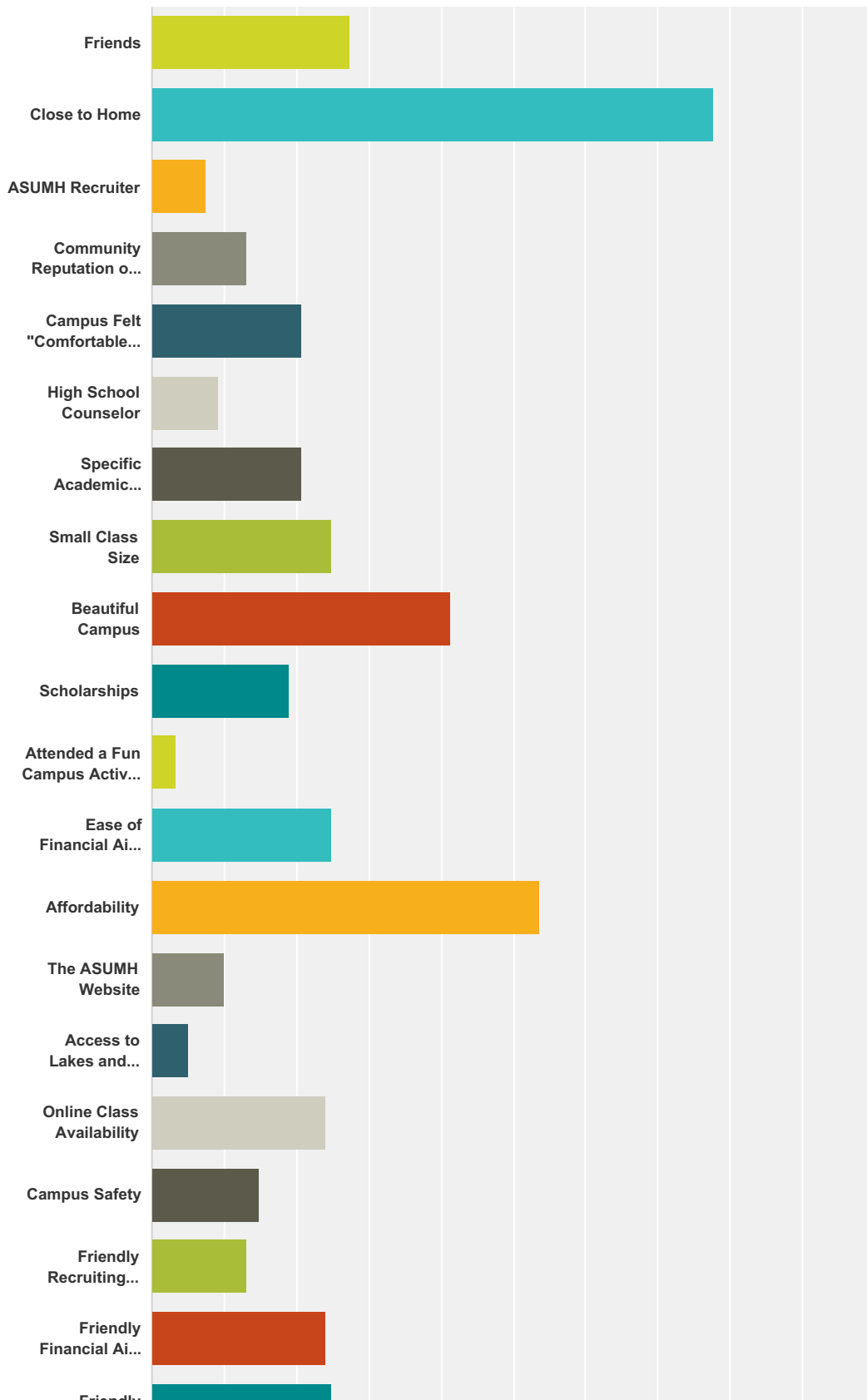
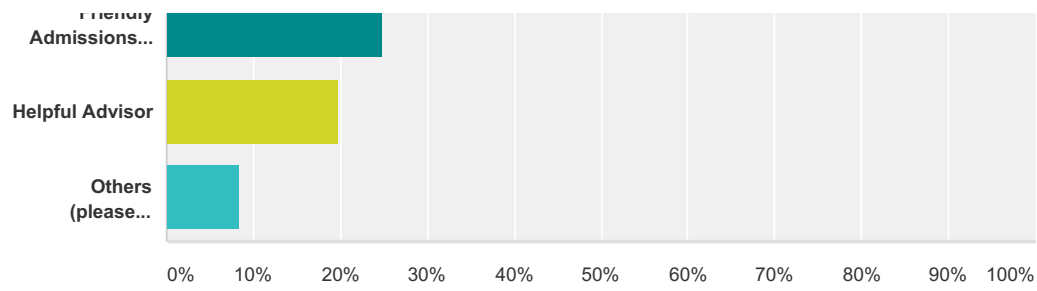


Q1 What influenced you to choose ASUMH? (Select all that apply)

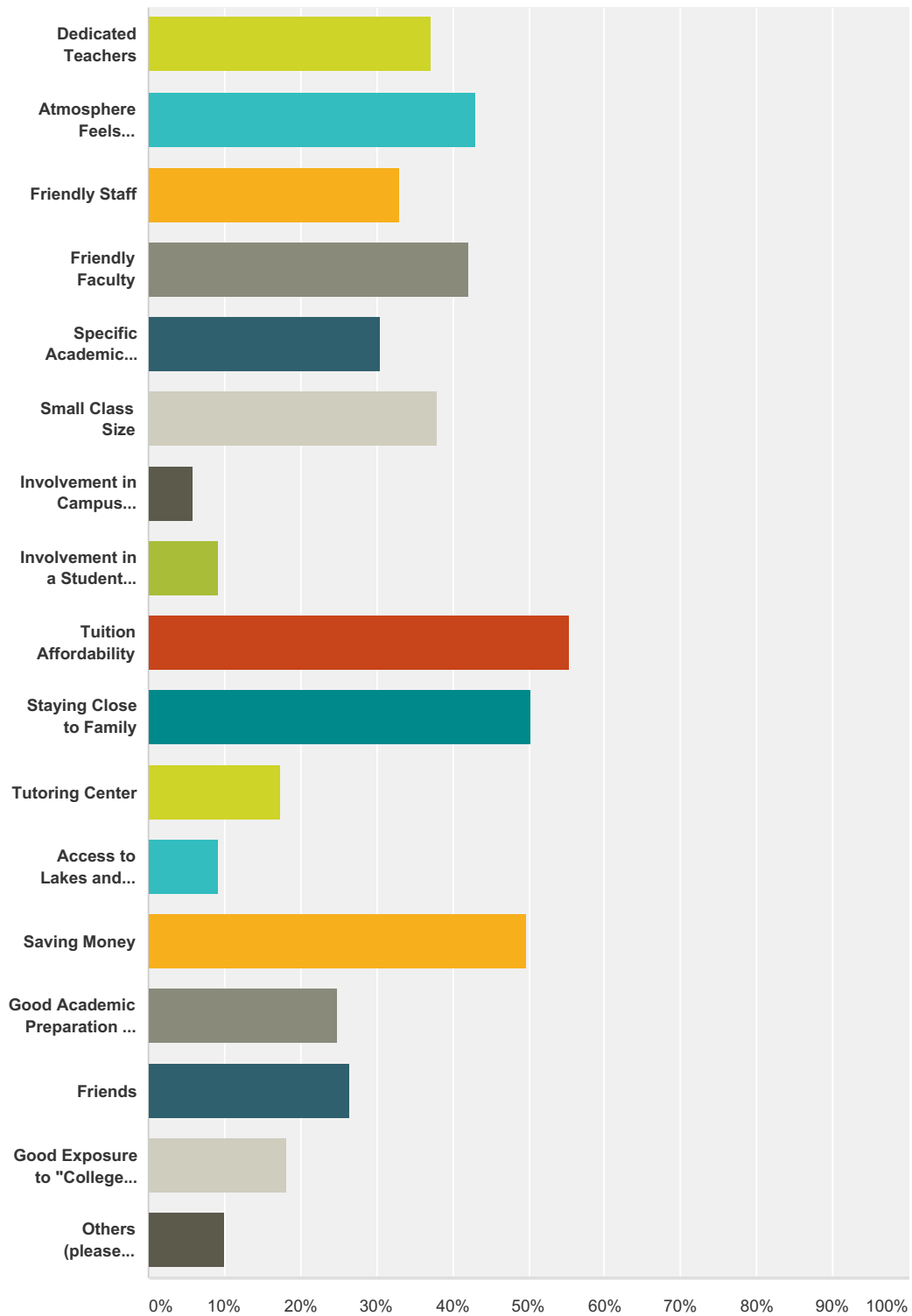
